- 1. We often hear of "the patience of Job." What enabled him to persevere through these incredible trials like he did?
- 2. What was Job doing in the sacrifices for his children? What did he fear, and why did he feel his actions would be helpful? What might the equivalent act for a Christian parent today be?
- 3. Have you ever experienced anything on the scale of Job's trials? What were the circumstances? Did you pass or fail the test? What was the test?
- 4. Why was Satan allowed to be with the "sons of God" in 1:6 and 2:1?
- 5. Have you ever struggled with the concept of an all-powerful, all-loving God allowing the presence of evil, and evil acts and natural tragedies? What have you concluded about God? What are the possibilities?
- 6. Why did God single out Job to Satan? Is his trial a punishment or an honor?
- 7. Do you think Job ever knew in his lifetime what caused all this to come upon him?
- 8. Read I Peter 1:6-7. Do you believe that trials can prove your faith to be real? How do they do that? Can faith be proved to be genuine without trials?
- 9. How did the Apostle Paul prove his own faith was genuine? (Hint: see 2 Corinthians 11:23-27)
- 10. If you have failed the test under pressure at some point in your life, is it an unforgivable sin? How can you become strengthened for the next time?
- 11. How strong would you say your concept of God's ultimate sovereignty is?
