- How did that influence my understanding of “assurance of salvation?”
- Do I ever turn to a version of “dead works” (Heb. 6:1) for repentance, redemption, or forgiveness? How so?

What's Next?

- Jesus establishes our righteousness through His atoning work on the Cross. Evaluate how you seek repentance (being in the right) outside of Him (e.g. social media; acceptance from friends, family, or society), and cut that out of your life. Repent!

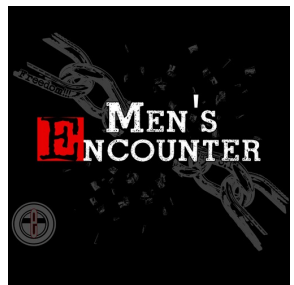
